1. Disco dates

Use Halloween game from last year, glow sticks, hot food, drinks, sweets and raffle (Bowling voucher and Halloween hampers with sweets and Halloween related items). Sell tickets beforehand for the disco CW will design and send to the office for Friends to sell ASAP.

Still run discos as Fridays.

Prospective disco dates:

- Christmas disco – 21st December
- Valentines (fancy dress) – 15th February
- Easter – 12th April
- Summer (Hawaiian theme) – Whenever available

EF will liaise with school and DJ John to set dates for discos.

2. Christmas cards / mugs

Christmas card companies (dandy art house and ?sprout) were mentioned as they were used before. EF has sourced some companies – need to begin to design cards ASAP, whichever company used we need an order form to send home.

CW will find cheapest card company and look into Salt Pots or a similar company decorating personalised Christmas tree decorations and mugs etc for gifts as an alternative to the Secret Santa event, anyone have any more ideas on this.

3. Christmas or Summer fair

We agreed that we would like to run both fairs, very different and far enough apart. Run inflatables alongside Summer fair as mentioned last year.

4. Fundraisers

- Pumpkin carving competition and Halloween fancy dress on 31st October – 50p for a numbered tag to attach to your entry and £1 fancy dress.
- Can we run the Christmas movie night again? Watch Arthur Christmas sell tickets as before for the cinema treat bags, watch the movie in PJs etc.
- Sell lost property uniforms 50p an item then set a date for blue bags (perhaps ask for donations of uniforms from parents instead of throwing away?).
- Baildon Carnival – TP to organise (are we parading?), we will run a stall again.
- Organise a run – summer after school or weekend?
