

The National Curriculum (NC) provides both the content and the framework for much of what we teach at Hoyle Court Primary School, however we take every opportunity to enrich the framework. In the Early Years, children experience the seven areas of learning required as part of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. To ensure we achieve our vision for the children in our school, we have developed a curriculum which is ambitious and engaging. Our lessons are relevant to our children and draw, not only on our local community but the wider world. We provide children with clarity on their place in the world and the opportunities which are ahead of them. Every child is an individual and our curriculum is adapted to an offer in which all children are included and challenged. Our curriculum is broken down into strands which in addition to english and maths, include: history, geography, art, DT, Science, music, ICT, drama, MfL, PSHE and RE. We have curriculum experts who oversee their specialist curriculum areas, harnessing their own individual knowledge and enthusiasm to share excellent subject knowledge across the curriculum. They are responsible for ensuring progress throughout school. Our staff work in base teams, including Early years, key stage 1, lower key stage 2 and upper key stage 2. Our teams plan the curriculum and delivery together and moderate not only between themselves but also externally to ensure quality assurance.
