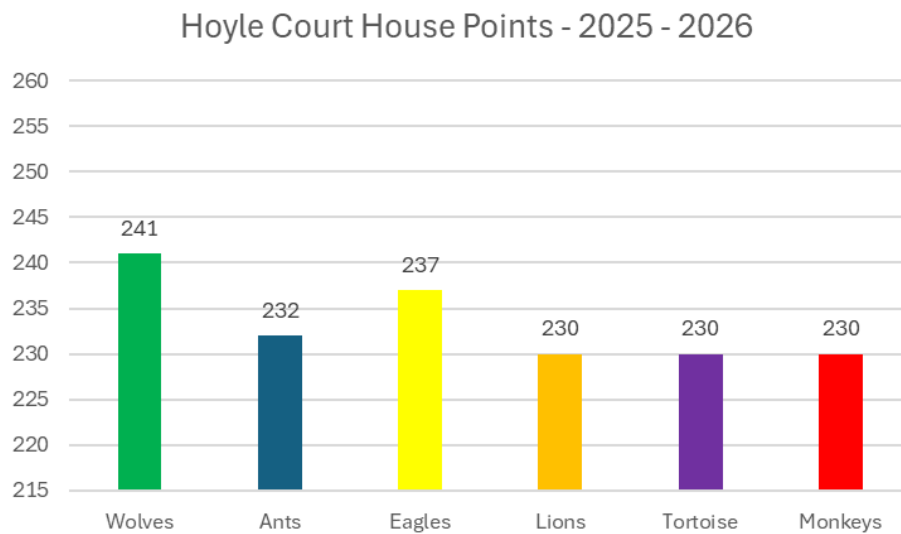
Year 1 and nursery were busy partying in school and Santa also popped into school on Monday.
