Good afternoon,

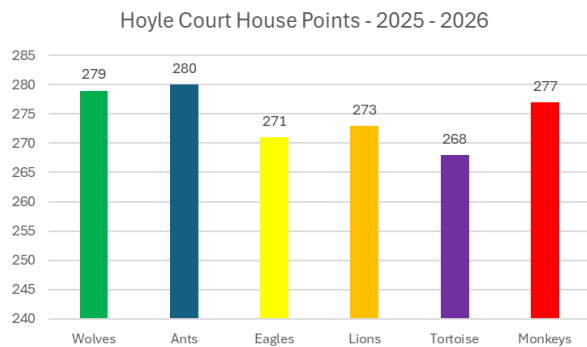
