Year 6 Leavers Video

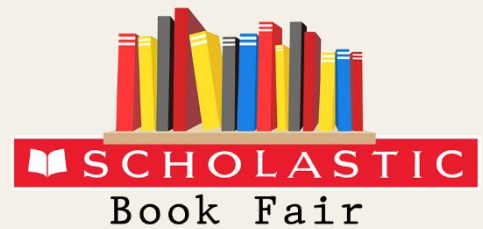
